Some covid news: the Lord has been gracious to all our kids with no Covid ! We are grateful and thank you for praying for our kiddos . Both in Thailand and Cambodia schools are slowly starting to open with social distancing and rotating days but I can see the kids so happy to get out and around. Not to mention the staff are happy too!

We appreciate the brethren who gave financially to help our feeding outreach in Kabul Spean where we fed around 2,000 people in the slums, plus distributed many bags of rice and noodles! It was very helpful in the time of need and lots of people heard about Jesus! Also since I can't travel internationally, I can travel domestically . So I had a very promising time down south at the Phangnga Home! Led devotions with the staff and did my usual grandma thing, ICE CREAM for everyone, it was a blast. Plus its so beautiful there!

The sad news : Yelang , who has been at our home since 4 years old and is our present MMF Thai Administator , sadly her cancer has returned <sup>(2)</sup>. The cancer growth was so rapid that it created blood clots in her right leg and is in a wheel chair. She is doing a bit better, still has that lovely smile and Lord willing



starting chemo again next Tuesday. Yelang's doctor prognosis is not very encouraging but Yelang's daily strength and courage is coming from the Lord. There is a financial cost/need as her regular chemo is from her gov't insurance but the doctors wants her to go another step and use "targeted therapy". It will cost roughly \$866. Dollars per treatment, times 5 treatment, equals \$4,330. US dollars in total. If anyone wants to help with her treatment just send it to MFI with a note for Yelang cancer treatment. The link is below. She and I would be very grateful. Can you please say an extra prayer for her sister Yemui, she is Yelang's main caregiver, not easy emotionally eh?

Some great news now : In one of the opening pictures is a picture of Sherry and Yaro, they came by for one last prayer time before going to Bangkok Bible Seminary, so exciting to see the young teenagers go on with the things of God. Plus Somchai (pic below) is going to Bible School in Khon Kaen for one year and Apuang is doing a 3 month bible course with Ywam in Poipet. Glory to God!! Also please pray for Chalerm as he takes over leadership at the Chiangrai Home (for 6 months) as Yemui takes care of her sister Yelang.
